The Organization was formed in order to conserve the natural resources of its five county area while improving the economic and social well-being of all area citizens. The council forms partnerships with local groups to implement projects that will improve family income; enhance community services and infrastructure; reduce soil erosion and damages from sediment; and expand economic opportunities; while sustaining the natural resource base that has provided us with such a high quality of life.

The Organization's purpose is to provide both technical and financial assistance to units of government in installing erosion control projects on land having public benefits, recreational projects, and general rural development efforts. The Council seeks funds from private foundations, federal, state and local governments, etc. The reason for applying for this exemption is that the foundations usually require the certification of exemption before they will commit funds to a project.
