

# CAWACO RESOURCE CONSERVATION & DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL GRANT PROGRAM FACT SHEET

The Cawaco RC&D Council is actively involved in the management of multi-county, crossjurisdictional projects that address natural, financial, and/or human resource opportunities within Blount, Chilton, Jefferson, Shelby, and Walker Counties. Many of these projects involve partnerships between local businesses, governmental agencies and citizen volunteers.

### **BASIC INFO**

- We serve Blount, Chilton, Jefferson, Shelby and Walker Counties of Alabama
- We award approximately \$200,000 in grants each year
- The grant cycle is open year-round, with awards announced in <u>September</u>
- Final reports are due August 1 of each year
- 2019 grants will be announced in September 2018 and will close out in August of 2019
- Most awards are \$5,000 or less
- New applicants should submit a letter of inquiry or obtain written recommendation from a Cawaco Board Member
- ALL GRANTS ARE REIMBURSABLE
- Grantees who do not use their grant award and fail to cancel their grant are ineligible to reapply for a minimum of 2 years

#### How Are Grants Chosen?

#### Each year, we receive far more applications than we can possibly fund.

- A Board Member from each county serves on the Grant Committee
- The Grant Committee members review and score each grant
- The Grant Committee considers the following:
  - Projects where a small amount will make a big impact
  - Community need, public support, and area/number of people affected
  - Partnerships, volunteers and donations
  - Grants must meet Cawaco Goals and Objectives
  - If the grant committee member knows you or your organization, it helps.
- Grants scores are compiled and averaged, failing grants get no further review
- After all grants are reviewed and scored, the grant committee meets to make the final decision
