



Reed Harvey Community Greenway Volunteer Event

DATE: Saturday, September 29, 2012 (rain or shine)

DIRECTIONS: From downtown, take Interstate 59 North, take Exit 134 (AL 75, Roebuck Parkway), turn left on Roebuck Parkway. Drive 3.5 miles to Polly Reed Road, turn right on Polly Reed. Pass Reed Harvey Park, pass Kim Road, drive straight at the curve onto Barrington Lane. Park in the circle.

BACKGROUND: National Fish and Wildlife Foundation Five Star Grant provided funds to finish a new section of the Five Mile Creek Greenway.

DETAILS: Volunteers will install Tree Identification markers along the tree trail, pickup trash, remove privet, and plant willow sprigs in the creek bank. Wear shoes that can get wet.
