For job/trade skill training, scholarships, field trips, books, or materials Must fulfill an educational purpose and reach a large audience \$5,000 minimum; \$20,000 maximum Challenge For materials, infrastructure, or educational/safety equipment \$5,000 minimum; \$20,000 maximum

\*\*NOTE: The average project funded ranges between \$5,000 – \$10,000. Cawaco grants are reimburasable. You must complete your project and submit documentation to receive payment.
