Funding Priorities (2019-2023)

- Workforce development
- Access to local food (school and community gardens, projects that address food insecurity)
- Access to outdoor recreation (trails, canoe launches, signage, design, etc.)
- Community planning and design
- First responder support
- Improvement of local habitat

Types of Grants

Education:

- For job/trade skill training, scholarships, field trips, books, or materials
- Must fulfill an educational purpose and reach a large audience

\$5,000 minimum; \$20,000 maximum

Challenge

- For materials, infrastructure, or educational/safety equipment

\$5,000 minimum; \$20,000 maximum

[FY2022 - Historic Preservation Fund- Annual State Historic Preservation Office Grants](#)

Deadline: April 30

The purposes of this program are to provide matching grants to States for the identification, evaluation, and protection of historic properties by such means as: survey, planning, technical assistance, physical preservation, Federal tax incentives available for historic properties, nominations to the National Register of Historic Places, distribution of funding to Certified Local Governments, and to assist Federal, State, and Local Government agencies, nonprofit organizations and private individuals in carrying out historic preservation activities. Awards under this program must comply with and support 54 USC 301 et seq. (commonly known as the National Historic Preservation Act)

The State of Alabama is offering grants to Volunteer Fire Departments and Rural Hospitals. Deadline for Fire Department applications is March 25. Deadline for Hospitals is April 1.
